Good luck to the Year 3/4 Football team who are competing in the Burslem tournament tonight.

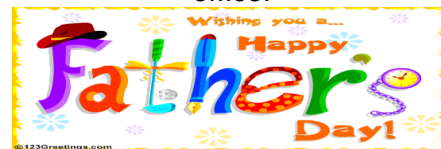


Good luck to our athletes who are taking part in the track events at Northwood on Tuesday 20th June.
