PE Funding 2017 - 2018

The Government provide funding for P.E in all school. This funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport and will see money going directly to primary school head teachers to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children. Schools will have to spend the sport funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this.

The Governors agree that the money must be used so that:

- ▶ All children benefit regardless of sporting ability
- ▶ That the most able children are given the opportunity to compete in advanced tournaments
- ▶ That staff have access to training opportunities and continued professional development.

The total amount of funding we have received this year is **£15,761.00**

Sport Funding

- ▶ We have spent the majority of our Sport funding on provision with Premier Sports. This has the greatest impact on sports at Sneyd Green because:
- ▶ We have 2 hours of Continued Professional Development every week. This rotates termly and all staff have access to planning.
- ▶ We have a KS1 and KS2 WOW after school clubs every week.
- ▶ We provide KS1 Games club and KS2 Change 4 Life club which encourages the less active children in our school to become more involved with PE.
- ▶ We also provide a KS1 and KS2 Sports Stars Club which support our gifted and talented pupils in sports.
- ▶ We also run a weekly competition club.
- ▶ We actively take part in level 2 competitions and compete with other schools in the area in sports such as Fencing, Laser Tag, Archery and Cheerleading.
- ▶ Premier Sports provide our school with a reliable Baseline Measurement test.

CPD

KS1 Change 4 Life (Games Club)

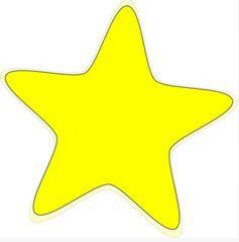
- ▶ This club is for KS1 children to encourage them to become more physically active.

- ▶ The club also teaches pupils how to live an active and healthy lifestyle.



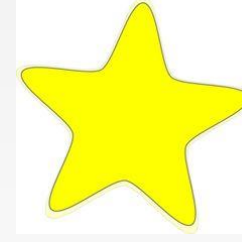
KS2 Change 4 Life

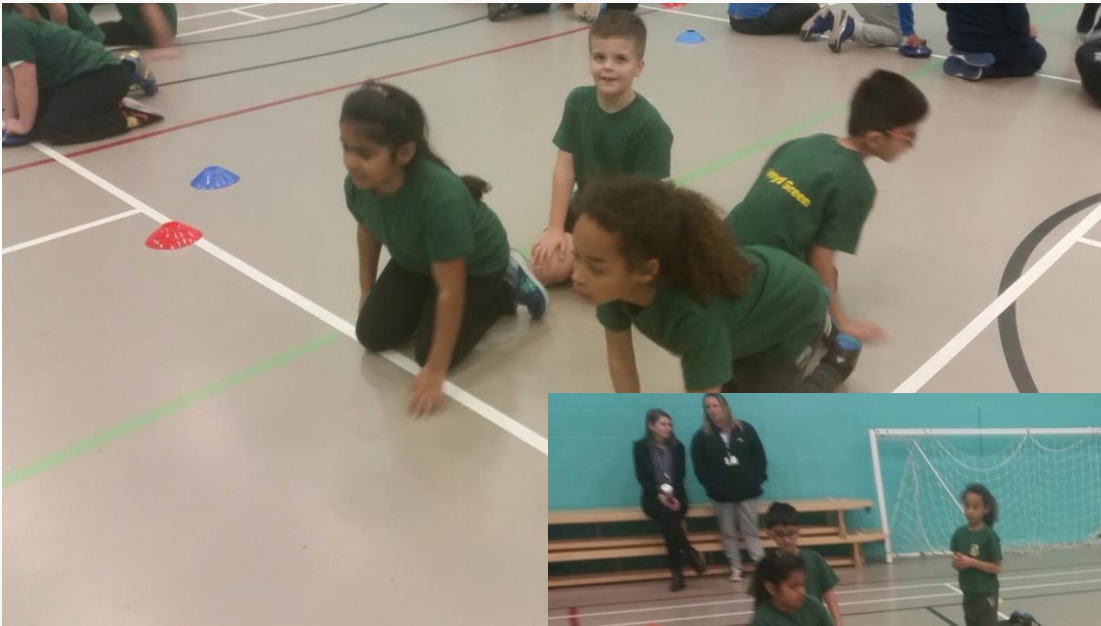
